Students will learn how to burn and shade the faux leather tooling effect, they will learn how to make a custom cut on the top of the gourd if desired, how to attach small studs, and paint the faux stitching

Students will need to bring:

- Gourd about 7 or 8 inches wide opened at the top and well cleaned out
- Gourd saw with extra blades
- Needle shoe compass (or ruler)
- Wood burner with **spear tip** and **spoon shader tip**
- Electric drill with 3/32 or 1/16 inch bit (instructor will have a bit to loan)
- Heat setter
- Good quality dust mask

Instructor will provide:

- Ink dyes & paint
- Fine paint brushes
- Pattern
- Blue studs/beads
