



# Snail and Mushroom

Teacher: Olive Moore

This class is for all skill levels. The snail is made with a “mini” canteen gourd. The pattern on the shell is woodburned and painted with metallic ink dye. Learn to manipulate epoxy clay to form the snail’s body. The snail fits on a garden stake if desired. The mushroom is two separate gourds. Learn how to “create” your own mold markings on the mushroom cap and an easy way to make the underside of the mushroom look real. The butterfly perched on the mushroom will be made in a silicone mold and you will learn how to make your own silicone molds for other projects. This is a full day class and you will leave with two finished gourd projects.

## Materials that will be included:

- ★ Three Gourds
- ★ 2 oz. tube of Quikwood
- ★ Gloves, sponges, brushes
- ★ All surface materials
- ★ Detailed instructions

## Tools and supplies you will need to bring:

- Wood burner and spear tip
- Gourd saw if you have one or carver with A cutting wheel
- Small paint brushes
- Heat tool
- Basic tool kit (pencil, eraser, etc)
